Exhibitors may not assign, sublet or apportion to other persons or firms the whole or any part of the space allocated and may not advertise or display goods or services other than those manufactured or sold by them in the regular course of their business. However, an exhibitor may use equipment or the product of another exhibitor in the display for the purpose of better product presentation of his/her own product.

All table cancellations must be submitted to the OATAG Exhibits Coordinator in writing. Cancellations made after August 15, 2008 will be assessed a cancellation fee of 50% of the total table cost. No refunds will be given on cancellations received on or after September 15, 2008.
